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Highlighted Project: Middle School Athletic Tracks

In June of 2008, FWISD held a groundbreaking ceremony to celebrate the kick off of the 2007 Capital Improvement Program (CIP). Attended by members of the Board of Education, elected officials, Dr. Melody Johnson, Superintendent of Schools, Walter Dansby, Deputy Superintendent CIP, FWISD/DMJM staff and public, the ceremony also marked the start of the first construction project.

Over the summer months Sports Constructors, Inc., the General Contractor and Schrickel, Rollins & Associates, the Architect/Engineer, led the effort to renovate fifteen tracks and build one new track at Meadowbrook Middle School. The total Construction budget of the athletic track project was \$3,002,847.00. The improvements included new asphalt base, concrete curbing and laying all-weather surface materials.

Meadowbrook Middle School and the community are benefiting from the new track. The projects were completed in September 2008, under budget and slightly behind schedule due to rain delays.

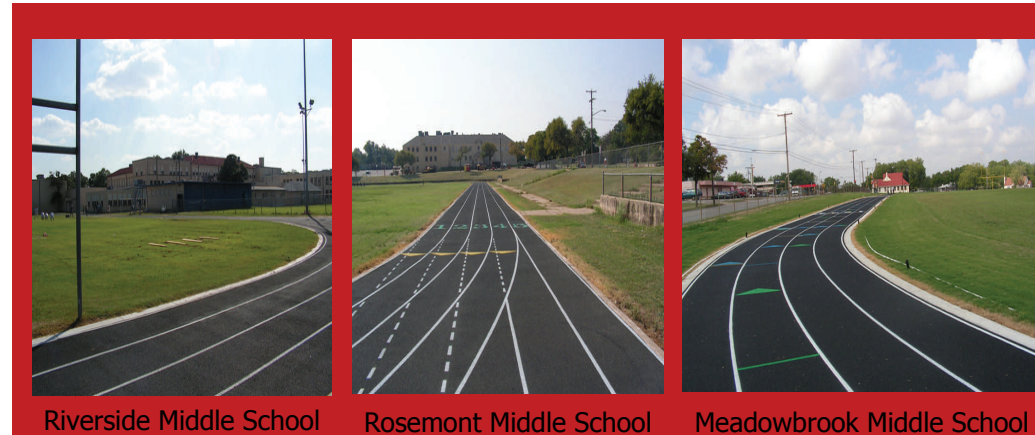
Three more tracks will be completed in subsequent phases of the CIP. At completion, all middle schools will have new track surfaces provided with 2007 bond funds.
