There were thirteen submitted proposals and the selection committee was pleased with the response. Bid package 009 consists of three elementary schools with a construction value of \$6.1 million. The goal of the Construction Bid Preview is to make the Competitive Sealed Proposal (CSP) method clear to potential proposers, present current information about the projects and to create networking opportunities for attendees. Although Phase 2/2A is not yet in the construction phase we will also be discussing those projects valued at \$146.9 million.
