Skills	Students will form and use nouns, verbs, adjectives and pronouns, form commands, courtesy, and Latin derivatives.	Students will form and use pronouns, adjectives, pronouns, and adverbs, form and use the present, imperfect, perfect tenses and the dative case.			
Student Products	Students will identify and label Latin vs., English parts of speech, design a <i>bula</i> with name, and create and label a home.	Students will create symbols representing parts of speech to form original sentences and write an eyewitness account of the eruption of Vesuvius.			
Questions Parents Can Ask	What is a bula? How was a Roman home designed and furnished? What are some English words derived from Latin?	What do the practices and products of the Roman reveal about them? In what ways did the beliefs of the Greeks and Romans shape their art and literature?			
Special Notes	Encourage students to create flashcards of Roman numerals and to practice creating original sentences in Latin.	Encourage students to maintain accumulative verb conjugation charts. Discuss political campaigns in Rome and compare to modern day ones.
