Helping Youth Pursue Excellence (HYPE): This initiative is designed for 8th grade students to gain a positive self-image and develop excellent communication skills by participating in one of five exciting categories: art, comedy, dance, drama, or poetry. HYPE meets for seven Saturday morning sessions.

I DREAM, I LEARN, I WIN SUMMIT(IDLW): The purpose of this event is to create a college bound culture within our community, create a vision of achievement for students and parents, and the understanding of the value for education and the doors that will open for all individuals.

LEADERSHIP ACADEMY (LA): Leadership Academy is a motivational and leadership program that helps students discover their voice and learn to believe in themselves. Participating 9th through 10th graders will stay at Texas Christian University for four days and three nights where they meet and interact with their peers, trainers, and college students.

CHILDREN'S ORAL HEALTH COALITION (COCH): Children's Oral Health Coalition helps prevent tooth decay in young children by donating new, individually-wrapped children's toothbrushes. Toothbrushes will be distributed to underserved families throughout the year through the work of the Children's Oral Health Coalition led by Cook Children's Hospital. Volunteers are needed to assemble dental hygiene packets.

BACK TO SCHOOL EXTRAVAGANZA (B2SE): The TarrantNet's goal is to support underserved students within your school through the distribution of school uniforms, backpacks, and school supplies. The distribution will take place during the Back to School Extravaganza which will be held on the campus of Texas Wesleyan University.

HISPANIC WELLNESS FAIR: The Hispanic Wellness Fair is a community event sponsored by the Hispanic Health Coalition that provides free health care and preventive services. Free services include: immunizations for children, dental screenings/prevention services for children, mammograms, cholesterol tests, diabetes tests (blood sugar), bone density assessments, and many more health services.

MULTICULTURAL LEADERSHIP SEMINAR (MLS): The Multicultural Leadership Seminar gives participating 11th and 12th grade students the opportunity to stay at a college campus for one week. During their stay, students tour the campus, visit surrounding universities, and attend workshops that range from the college admissions process and scholarships to campus life and cultural differences. This initiative is tailored to meet the needs of underserved students with potential to succeed at institutions of higher learning.

GEAR UP 4 SCHOOL: Unity One Federal Credit Union provided 600 school children with back-to-school supplies during its event at its North Side branch.

AMERICAN INDIAN POW WOW: The Pow Wow is a cultural event that allows the community to learn about and honor the American Indian Heritage. The purpose of the American Indian Education Program is to provide academic support through cultural education.
