Required Immunizations**

**Pre-Kindergarten (Pre-K)**

<b>Vaccine</b>	<b>Required Doses</b>
<b>Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis (DTaP)</b>	4 doses
<b>Polio (IPV)</b>	3 doses
<b>Measles Mumps, Rubella (MMR)</b>	1 dose on or after 12 months of age (1 <sup>st</sup> birthday)
<b>Haemophilus Influenzae type b conjugate vaccine (Hib)</b>	1-4 doses 1 dose if given on or after 15 months <b>OR</b> 3-4 doses (Completed series with the last dose given on or after 12 months of age)
<b>Varicella</b>	1 dose on or after 12 months of age (1 <sup>st</sup> birthday) if no history of chickenpox
<b>Hepatitis A</b>	2 doses
<b>Hepatitis B</b>	3 doses
<b>Pneumococcal Conjugate Vaccine (PCV7)</b>	1-4 doses 1 dose if given on or after 2nd birthday <b>OR</b> 2 doses if both given on or after 12 months of age and 8 weeks apart <b>OR</b> 3-4 doses if last dose was given on or after 12 months of age (1st birthday)

**Kindergarten through 12 (K-12)**

Vaccine	Required Doses
<b>Diphtheria, Tetanus Toxoid, and Pertussis Vaccine (DTaP/DTP/DT/Tdap/Td)</b>	Five doses; however, 4 doses meet the requirement if the 4 <sup>th</sup> dose was given on or after the 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday. <b>Students 7 years or older:</b> Three doses of any combination vaccine of any combination Tdap/Td/DTP/DTaP One dose of Tdap/Td required ten years after last dose of DTP/DTaP/DT.
<b>Polio (IPV)</b>	Four doses; however, 3 doses meet the requirement if the 3 <sup>rd</sup> dose was given on or after the 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday.
<b>Measles Mumps, Rubella (MMR)</b>	Two doses; both on or after the first birthday.
<b>Hepatitis B</b>	Three doses are required.
<b>Varicella</b>	One dose on or after the 1st birthday. (Two doses if vaccine given at 13 years of age or older.)
