Job Duties	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Preserve public health and diminish or eliminate hazards or potential hazards caused by the presence of asbestos, volatile organic compounds (VOCs), formaldehyde, pesticides, carbon dioxide, carbon monoxide, IAQ issues, or mold in school buildings and other public issues. · Provide professional services to the District concerning asbestos, lead, IAQ, and mold building surveys, assessment of condition of materials, planned operations and maintenance, and compliance with work practices and standards. · Evaluate possible environmental abatement projects and help prepare plans, specifications, schedules, and contract options for abatement projects. · Represent the interest of the District during the conduct of an environmental abatement project, including · Advise on the selection and use of appropriate personal protective equipment for all environmental related activities. · Provide environmental reports for issues such as, underground storage tanks (UST), hazardous waste, PCBs, Asbestos, soil contamination, Mercury spills and lead based paints, and public water and sewage systems. · Perform other job related duties as assigned.
