## GRADUATING SENIORS

Each student who plans to graduate at the close of the 2009 summer session is required to present the application for admission at the time of registration, complete with the following information:

1. Subject(s) needed to complete requirements
2. Number of high school credits completed
3. Signature of home school principal

## TAKS/TAAS TUTORIALS

TAKS/TAAS tutoring will be offered for students who did not pass the TAAS and/or TAKS during the 2008-2009 school year and who must pass the exit test in order to receive a diploma. This program will provide intensive instruction on the Writing, Reading, Mathematics, Social Studies and Science objectives for the exit level test.

## ENRICHMENT PROGRAMS

### Improving Reasoning, Verbal and Mathematics Skills

The Fort Worth ISD will offer summer PSAT/SAT preparation courses at five high school sites in June. Registration information and dates are available from the counseling offices or academic coordinators in district high schools. The courses will strengthen skills of interested students. Any student who will be in high school during the 2009-2010 school year is eligible to attend. Interested students are encouraged to register early to be accepted at their preferred site and so that materials may be purchased and prepared for them. Class sizes will range from 14 to 16 students. PSAT/SAT preparation sites include Arlington Heights, Carter-Riverside, Dunbar, Paschal and Southwest high schools. The price for the course is \$175 for Fort Worth ISD students and \$225 for students from other districts or private schools.

### High School Language Center Summer School Programs

A credit program will be held at Carter-Riverside High School, 3301 Yucca. Courses offered will include Algebra I, Algebra II, Geometry, Biology, United States Government, Economics, World Geography and Integrated Physics and Chemistry (one full credit per course). The Bilingual/ESL Department will handle registration, transportation, materials, etc. There is no cost for students. **Contact Genna Edmonds at 817.871.2530** if you have questions.

## HIGH SCHOOL MAKEUP PROGRAM

### Target Population:

1. Students who have failed a semester class
2. Students whose diagnostic test score indicates a strong possibility of successfully passing final test
3. Students who failed mathematics, science, social studies or language arts

### Design of Program

A diagnostic test will be administered to the student in order to design a specific program to address the student's needs. The student will attend a four-hour daily session that will extend over a one-week period (total of 20 hours). Students will take the test on Saturday, June 13, 2009. The sessions will be taught by teachers who have received a special staff development program on alternative delivery of instruction. The ratio of students to teacher will be based on 15 to 1. Further, the students will be grouped after the teachers have analyzed the individual student diagnostic test results. Clusters of objectives to be taught will be identified and the instructor will be able to plan the course syllabus. If the student successfully masters 70% of the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills taught, then the teacher will award credit for the course. No honors or elective courses will be offered.

### High School Summer Program

The high school summer program offers extended educational opportunities in grades 9-12 for students who:

- >> Need intensive instruction in TAKS/TAAS preparation
- >> Wish to participate in course offerings allowing them to advance through the regular curriculum in a summer school setting, or
- >> Wish to participate in enrichment courses

At time of registration, student must bring proof (receipt) that other members in family will be attending summer school; otherwise, no discounts will be given. (This discount applies to the regular program and is for *Fort Worth ISD* students only.)
