11/9	Life Skills Curriculum	This course will provide an overview of the Life Skills along with a free copy of curriculum and student classroom set.	30	UTA Fort Worth rm. 119
11/9 8-5 p.m.	Disruptive Student Management	This course is a hands-on course designed to train you in techniques for controlling the “physical actions” of student violence directed at you or at another student, teacher or staff member. This eight-hour interactive course provides the skills needed for handling the physical actions of various age groups. Physical participation in comfortable clothing needed.	50	UTA Fort Worth rm. 112
11/9-10 8-5 p.m.	Drug Impairment Training	The DIBREP program consists of an overview of drugs and alcohol, identification, observable effects, and behavior characteristics. Participants will be able to conduct eye exams, vital signs, divided attention tests, poly drugs and the assessment process. The training is intended to help evaluate suspected drug use.	50	UTA Fort Worth rm. 111
12/7	Steps to Respect	<i>Steps to Respect</i> is a research based elementary bullying prevention curriculum program. Free curriculum will be provided.	20	PDC rm 223
12/1-3	Critical Incident Stress Management (CISM)	The three-day course prepares participants to understand a variety of crisis intervention services including pre and post incident crisis education, significant other support services, on-scene support services, crisis intervention for individuals, demobilizations after large-scale traumatic incidents, small group defusings, and the group intervention known as Critical Incident Stress Debriefings (CISD). This training counts as completion of both the Basic CISM and Individual/Peer Support CISM courses.	60	UTA Fort Worth rm. 113 and 114
12/4	Emergency Aftermath Recovery	This session will better prepare you to participate as a member of a trauma response team in executing techniques that help schools recover after a traumatic event. The skills learned will include: an overview of debriefings and other interventions, disaster planning and recovery logistics support. Participants will participate in simulated crisis situations and practice the organization of trauma response as well as intervention techniques.	75	UTA Fort Worth rm. 113 and 114
