We are now approaching our time to reunite for the 2020-2021 school year. Our virtual classes will start on September 8 through October 2nd. We are all excited to begin our journey together as a Woodway Family. I know we all have so many questions and concern about our new normal. Our plan will be to keep you updated as much as possible in the event of any campus or district changes.

At this time, we are developing an opening plan, focusing on campus instruction and campus safety protocols. Teachers have attended training in efforts to implement classroom procedures consistent with TEA, District and CDC guidance. All staff members have been trained on COVID screening, identification of symptoms, prevention of spread, and sanitation of work areas. All faculty and staff will return by August 31st to receive further district training and updates.

We understand there have been many changes within the previous weeks, however we will continue ongoing communication through the Woodway Elementary website, Instagram, Facebook and campus calls. It is our goal to ensure that your scholars receive high quality instruction for both in person and online.

We are listing immediate, key information regarding virtual learning/in-person learning:

- Students will be engaged in face-to-face instruction but will also have assignments to complete independently.
- Grades for virtual instruction will follow all District grading policies.
- All teachers will receive training specific to on-line instruction.
- Remote attendance will count in the same manner as on-campus (face-to-face) attendance.
- Students will be required to engage in instruction for 4 hours daily; Pre-K 3 hours.
- Teachers will maintain identified “office hours” to support student and parent communication.
- Chromebooks and hot spots are available for students who need technology. Please call the campus if technology is needed.
- Social Emotional Learning will be a part of virtual instruction.
- Teachers will use online platforms, email, text and phone in order to provide more direct communication to parents and families.
- Meet the Teacher Night will be conducted virtually through Zoom, and the links will be sent out to all parents by September 2nd.
- Parents will receive all Google classroom codes through Meet the Teacher Night, email, and phone calls.
- When students return for in-person instruction, social distancing procedures will be in place.
- When students return for in-person, the bathrooms and common areas will be deep cleaned each day during and after school hours.
- Breakfast and lunch will be served in the classroom until further notice.
- All students and staff will participate in health screening procedures before they enter the building. (Temperature check, hand sanitization)
- Student supply pick-up will take place the first week of September.
