Dear Parent or Guardian:

Welcome Sharks, to Marine Creek Collegiate High School, for the 2020-21 school year. We look forward to a great school year! We are working diligently to ensure your student's all-around success.

Dress Code is a great concern that we must address daily. Please support us by making sure your child is in the proper attire each day for online learning and before they leave for school for face-to-face instruction. Please remember, this dress code is a collaborative policy between MCCHS Community, FWISD, and Tarrant County College. We want to ensure that your student is safe and "College Ready". Students are expected to report to school and stay in the attire described below, the entire day:

## **TOPS** (*Applicable for Virtual/Online Instruction & Settings*)

- Color: Any color is permitted.
- Style: Collared (polo or Oxford) shirts or blouses, mock turtlenecks or turtlenecks---all must have sleeves.  
Logos or emblems may not exceed two inches. T-shirts shall not be worn as outer clothing.
- Students may wear MCCHS shirts and Polos to campus every day.
- Student will wear issued MCCHS polos on all field trips, community service, and/or designated days by the Principal.
- Student may wear college or university shirts of their choice on ***Fridays*** only, *as designated by the Principal*
- *Each student will be given one MCCHS shirt for the 2020-2021 school year. Additional MCCHS spirit wear can be purchased during the first week of school.*

## **BOTTOMS**

- Color: Any solid color is permitted.
- Style: Jeans, slacks, and capris are the only acceptable bottoms a MCCHS student may wear ---all must be hemmed or cuffed.
- Sagging pants are not permitted. Pants must be worn at the waistline and must not be more than 1 size larger than your waist.
- Capris must be close-fitting, mid-calf length, or longer tapered trousers.
- Bottoms must be free of holes, rips, shredding, tears, and/or embellishments.
- **Prohibited Bottoms:** Shorts, Jeggings, Leggings, Skorts, Windpants, Sweatpants, Dresses, Skirts, Yoga Pants, and Athletic Attire

## **SHOES**

- Style: Athletic shoes, loafers, dress shoes or other closed-toe shoes are acceptable. Shoelaces should be white or should match the color of the shoe. *All students must wear appropriate footwear.*
- **Prohibited Shoes:** House shoes, slides, flip-flops, sandals, open toe shoes, or any shoe without a back

## **STUDENT ID'S**

- ID's must be worn ***AT ALL TIMES*** and must be visible around the student's neck. ID's cannot be in backpacks, bags, in pockets, or underneath outerwear.
- A \$5.00 fee is required each time a student does not have their student ID. This ensures the safety and protection of our MCCHS students.

## **OTHER PROHIBITED ITEMS**

- Hats, doo-rags, skull caps, head coverings of any type (i.e., bandanas, sweat bands, etc.), are not to be worn or brought to school unless approved by the Principal.
- Hoods are not to be worn inside of any MCCHS or TCC Building or Classroom.

The MCCHS Team will make parent contacts for dress code violations. Your support is paramount in helping us with getting your scholar in dress code compliance, which may include bringing appropriate dress code attire to campus.
