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Lone Star Governance (LSG) Monitoring Calendar Minimum Requirements:

- (1) The monitoring calendar spans at least two years. Ideally, the Board's monitoring calendar spans across the Board's student outcome goals' 3-5 year deadlines.
- (2) Every student outcome goal is monitored <u>at least four times per year</u>. Ideally, no more than two student outcome goals are monitored each month.
- (3) Every constraint is monitored at least once per year. Ideally Boards self-evaluate against one Board Self-Constraint each month.

HB3 Board Adopted Goals and Plans: Progress Updates and Monitoring Reports:

Each board goal within each plan is required to be reported on in a public meeting at least once per year, but in order to monitor the progress towards achieving the goal it is recommended to deliver a progress monitoring report on each goal at least four times per year using a progress measure identified within each plan. The specific schedule for delivering each progress to the board will be identified on the board monitoring calendar. A progress monitoring report delivered to the board should include, at a minimum, the following:

- (1) The district outcome goal and the progress measure being monitored in the report
- (2) Data showing the overall progress for the district towards the yearly target
- (3) Data showing the overall progress of each applicable student group towards each group's yearly target
- (4) Information showing each applicable campus' overall progress
- (5) The superintendent's interpretation of performance and documentation that evidences the superintendent's interpretation and describes any needed next steps

Board Self-Evaluation and Superintendent's Evaluation - AE (LOCAL)

The Board shall conduct formative self-evaluations <u>at least quarterly</u> and, within 45 days prior to conducting the annual evaluation of the Superintendent, shall conduct an annual summative self-evaluation. The Board shall self-evaluate using the Quarterly Progress Tracker tool provided by Lone Star Governance.

The Board shall annually evaluate the Superintendent based on the school system's achievement of the Board's student outcome goals and compliance with the Superintendent's constraints. Accomplishment of at least 80 percent of the annual targets for either the student outcome goals (GPM) or of the adopted progress measures (CPM) shall be an automatic indicator of success; below that threshold, the Board's judgment shall be the indicator of success.
