Fort Worth ISD Student Outcome Goals

Early Literacy



GOAL1:

Increase the percentage of 3rd grade students who score at meets grade level or above on STAAR Reading from 34% to 47% by August 2024.

Early Math



GOAL 2:

Increase the percentage of 3rd grade students who score at meets grade level or above on STAAR Mathematics from 34% to 45% by August 2024.

College, Career and Military Readiness



GOAL 3:

Increase the percentage of students graduating with a College, Career or Military Readiness indicator from 43% to 48% by August 2024.


