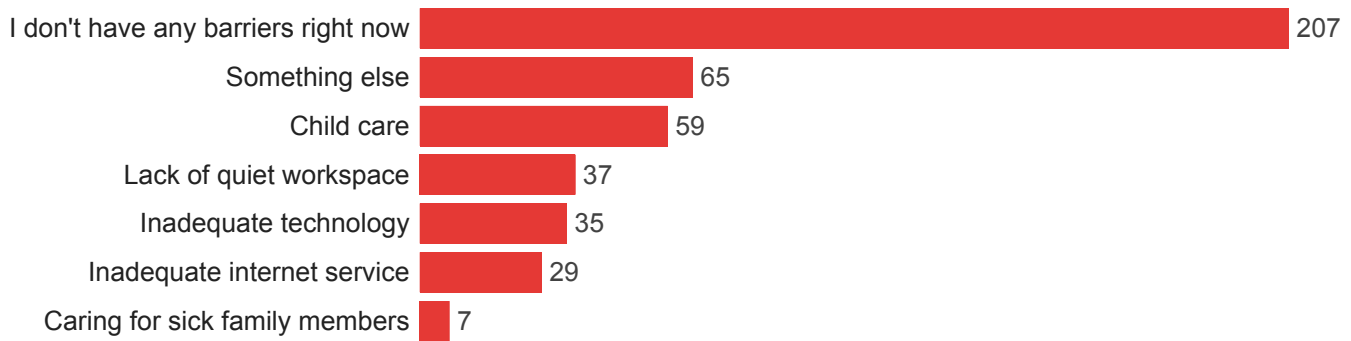




## Principal/Campus Leadership Perceptions of Remote Learning and Next Year Planning
