

One Million Program Agreement



Program rules and regulations are necessary to protect the students, devices, as well as the school network. The following guidelines are also in place to ensure that this technology serves as an effective instructional tool.

Students and their parents or guardians must agree to the following to become and remain eligible for the One Million Program. As part of the terms of agreement, the district agreed to the following and parents or guardians agreed during the device and internet agreement portions in PowerSchool (Online Registration):

1. The student will use at least 50% (5GB) of the monthly 10 Gigabyte (GB) data bandwidth requirement. The student must meet the minimum requirement of using 15 GBs or more of total bandwidth over a 3 month period. This usage requirement is not applicable to the Summer months.
2. The parent and student agree to follow all Fort Worth ISD regulations and policies governing the use of the hotspot device as well as all applicable State and Federal laws including copyright and intellectual property law pertaining to software and information.
3. The parent and student are responsible at all times for the care and appropriate use of the issued device and must adhere to these terms each time the device is used, including when it is not on school property.
4. The student will not deface the device or adhere stickers or other markings unless directed to by district staff.
5. The parent and student agree to ensure the device is secure and safe. The student agrees to handle the device carefully and protect it from potential sources of damage. When not in use, the device should always remain in the district-provided carrying case or equivalent.
6. The parent or student must report theft (or suspected theft), loss, damage, or malfunctioning of the device to school personnel immediately.
7. Upon request, the parent and student agree to deliver the issued device to school staff for technical inspection, device inventory, or other information.
8. The device and charger are the property of the Fort Worth ISD. All such issued equipment shall be returned to the school district in the event that the student withdrawals from the district.
9. All activity on the device will be filtered. Any attempt to disable the system's internal filter may result in disciplinary actions as well as removal of this free service to the student.
10. The parent/guardian accepts financial responsibility for loss and/or damage resulting from purposeful action or gross negligence. The replacement cost of the mobile hotspot is \$72.00. Replacement Micro-USB power adapters may be purchased by the user via Amazon or local retailers.
