***A middle or high school student who withdraws from a School of Choice or Program of Choice will have to return to his/her home school. A student will not be allowed to remain enrolled at the Program of Choice campus unless the student resides in the boundaries of the school, or applies and is approved for an Open Transfer.***

**Fort Worth Independent School District Athletic Eligibility**

All UIL Middle School and High School athletic programs in the Fort Worth Independent School District will be governed by eligibility and contest rules as listed in the Constitution and Contest Rules of the UIL and rules covering extracurricular activities adopted by the State Board of Education and/or the State Legislature and/or the Fort Worth ISD.

**a. Middle School**

1. If a middle school student is selected for and enrolls in a middle school Program of Choice or School of Choice, he/she will be eligible for all athletic activities at that special interest academic school.
2. If a middle school student is selected for the Program of Choice or School of Choice and is dropped from that school for any reason, he/she will be eligible at his/her home school upon re-enrollment at the home school.
3. Students in attendance at a middle school will be eligible to participate in athletics at the appropriate grade level.

**b. High School**

1. A student transferring from his/her home school to a Program of Choice, School of Choice, or Trimble Technical High School the first year he or she has opportunity to do so will be eligible to compete in sub-varsity and varsity contests at the Program of Choice academic school or School of Choice.
2. A student transferring from his or her home high school to another within the district the first year he/she has opportunity to do so will be eligible to compete only in sub-varsity contests at the new school. The student may participate at the varsity level after one calendar year of continuous enrollment at the new school. A Previous Athletic Participation Form will be required for all transfers. If it is determined that the transfer was for athletic purposes, the student may not participate at the varsity level for up to 3 years. Students who return to their home school will be ineligible to participate at the varsity level for one calendar year.
3. A student transferring from one high school to another high school within the district after the first opportunity he/she has to do so will be eligible to compete in sub-varsity contests at the new school, unless the District Executive Committee determines the primary reason for transfer is to participate in athletic contests, in which case the student would be declared ineligible for one (1) year from all levels of athletic participation.
