

FWISD Boundary Impact FAQs



- ***What do I do if I missed my Open House?***

- ***Are these changes expected to be implemented in the 2020 -2021 school year?***
 - The changes to aligned all Fort Worth ISD schools will take effect in accordance with the 2020 – 2021 school year.
- ***Transportation per Board Policy***
Board Policy CNA
 - A student who lives two or more miles from the assigned school, including a magnet (School of Choice) school to which the student has applied and has been accepted, will be eligible for transportation. The distance will be measured by the shortest route that may be traveled on public roads from the student’s home to the school.
 - The District may permit a student for whom the District does not receive state transportation funds to use District transportation, in accordance with time and space limitations and administrative regulations.
 - A student who transfers to a school other than the school to which he or she is assigned, without a corresponding change of address, will not be eligible for transportation.

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- Transportation is provided for all handicapped children and for regular program children who live beyond a two-mile radius from their assigned school. Children who attend special interest academic programs beyond a two (2)-mile radius will receive transportation from their home elementary school or designated pick up points.
- ***What if my child has younger siblings?***
 - Younger siblings will adhere to the new boundary changes for their attendance zone. Families who choose the “grandfathered in” option become responsible for transportation to and from school. Fort Worth ISD will not provide transportation to students outside of their assigned attendance zone.
 - Rising 4th and 7th grade students have the option to be “grandfathered in” and stay at their current campus.
 - Rising 8th grade students will be assigned to their newly aligned high school
 - Rising 9th, 10th and 11th grade students will have the option to remain at their current campus
- ***What if my child is enrolled in a Program of Choice?***
 - Fort Worth ISD students that have already been accepted into a Program of Choice will not be subject to the boundary changes to align schools. However, should the student decide that he/she no longer desires to attend or is no longer eligible to attend the School or Program of Choice will at that time transition to the campus that is aligned with his/her current address.
