The Family Resource Center (FRC) and Family Action Center (FAC) are centers that are based on FWISD school campuses in Fort Worth and aid families in need.

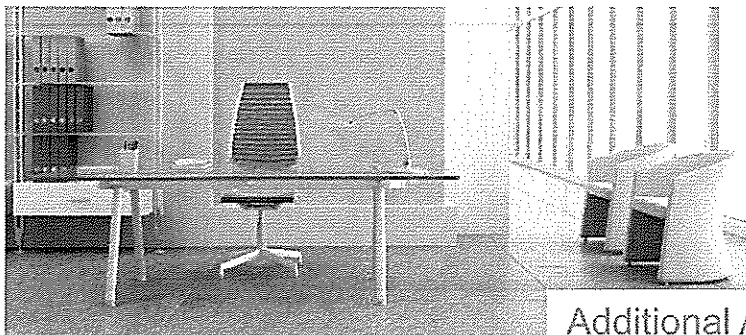
What we do...

How it's done...

FRC Staff will help you find the best services to meet the needs of your child. Agency services may include:

- *Individual, Family and Group Counseling
- *Psychiatric and Psychological Evaluation
- *Parent Education and Workshops Services are available
