# J.P. Elder Middle School

## In-Person Transition Plan

- ▶ All students must complete the pre-screening prior to arriving at school. This includes taking the student's temperature
- ▶ Parents must ensure they do not send a child to school if the child has COVID-19 symptoms or a lab-confirmed COVID-19.
- ▶ All students and staff must wear a mask while on campus
- ▶ Students are asked not to arrive on campus before 8:40
- ▶ Student on campus from 8:40 to 9:00 will be moved to the auditorium
- ▶ At 9:00 students will be escorted to cafeteria to pick-up breakfast
- ▶ Breakfast will be eaten in 1<sup>st</sup> period class

# J.P. Elder Middle School In-Person Transition Plan

- ▶ Once in 1<sup>st</sup> period, all students will have their temperature taken
- ▶ Any student with a temperature of 100.0 or higher will be sent to the nurse's office.
- ▶ The nurse will evaluate student and they will be sent home

# Elder In-Person Transition Plan Protocols

- ▶ Students must maintain social distancing of 6 feet when possible
- ▶ Students must use hand sanitizer when entering every class
- ▶ Teachers will eliminate shared supplies.
- ▶ Teachers will maintain a consistent daily seating chart.

# Elder In-Person Transition Plan

## Passing periods

- ▶ Hallways and stairways are marked one way to have as much social distancing as possible
- ▶ Restrooms will be closed during passing periods
- ▶ 6<sup>th</sup> grade restroom breaks 2<sup>nd</sup> period, 5<sup>th</sup> period and lunch
- ▶ 7<sup>th</sup> grade restroom breaks 2<sup>nd</sup> period, 5<sup>th</sup> period and lunch
- ▶ 8<sup>th</sup> grade restroom breaks 3<sup>rd</sup> period, 6<sup>th</sup> period and lunch

# Elder In-Person Transition Plan Lunch

- ▶ Students will be escorted to the cafeteria
- ▶ All lunches will be grab and go
- ▶ The first 130 student will eat in cafeteria
- ▶ The rest of the students will be escorted to the auditorium
- ▶ Students will not be allowed to go outside for the first two weeks

# Elder In-Person Transition Plan

## Dismissal

- ▶ Students that ride the bus will be escorted to the auditorium to wait for the bus to arrive
- ▶ Students that are being picked up will be escorted to designate areas.
- ▶ 6th grade on Park between Lee Ave and Lincoln Ave
- ▶ 7th grade on Lincoln Ave between 20th St and 21st St
- ▶ 8th grade on Lee Ave between 20th St and 21st St
- ▶ Walkers will be escorted off campus
