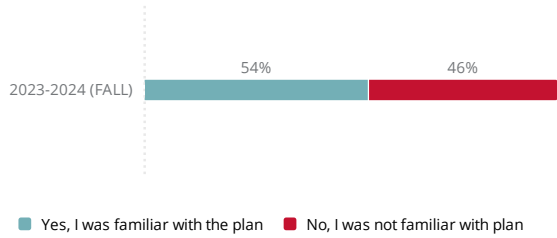

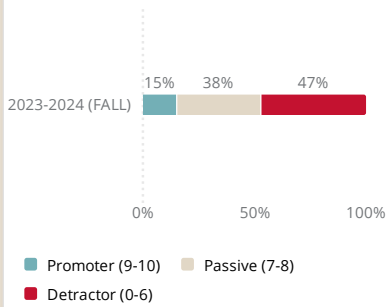

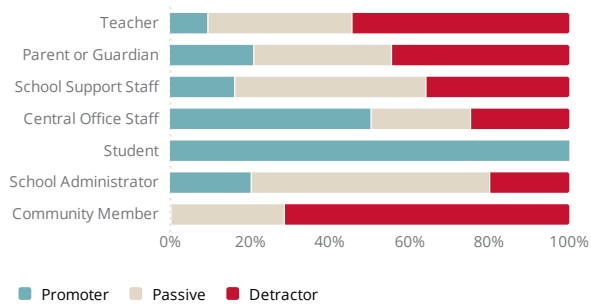

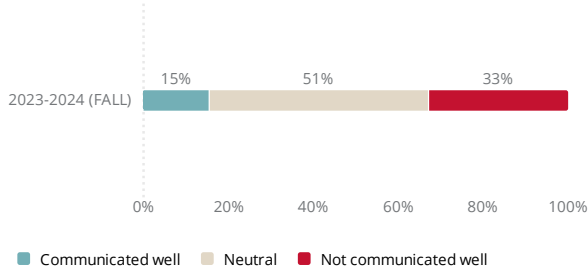
Net Promoter Score for the Continuity of Services Plan

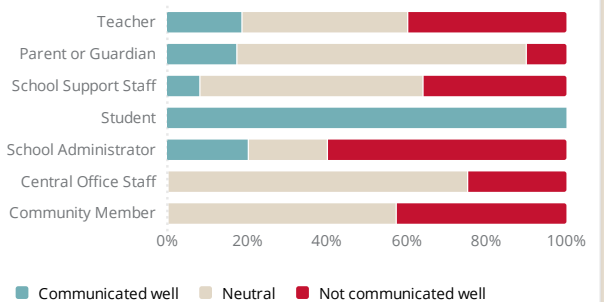

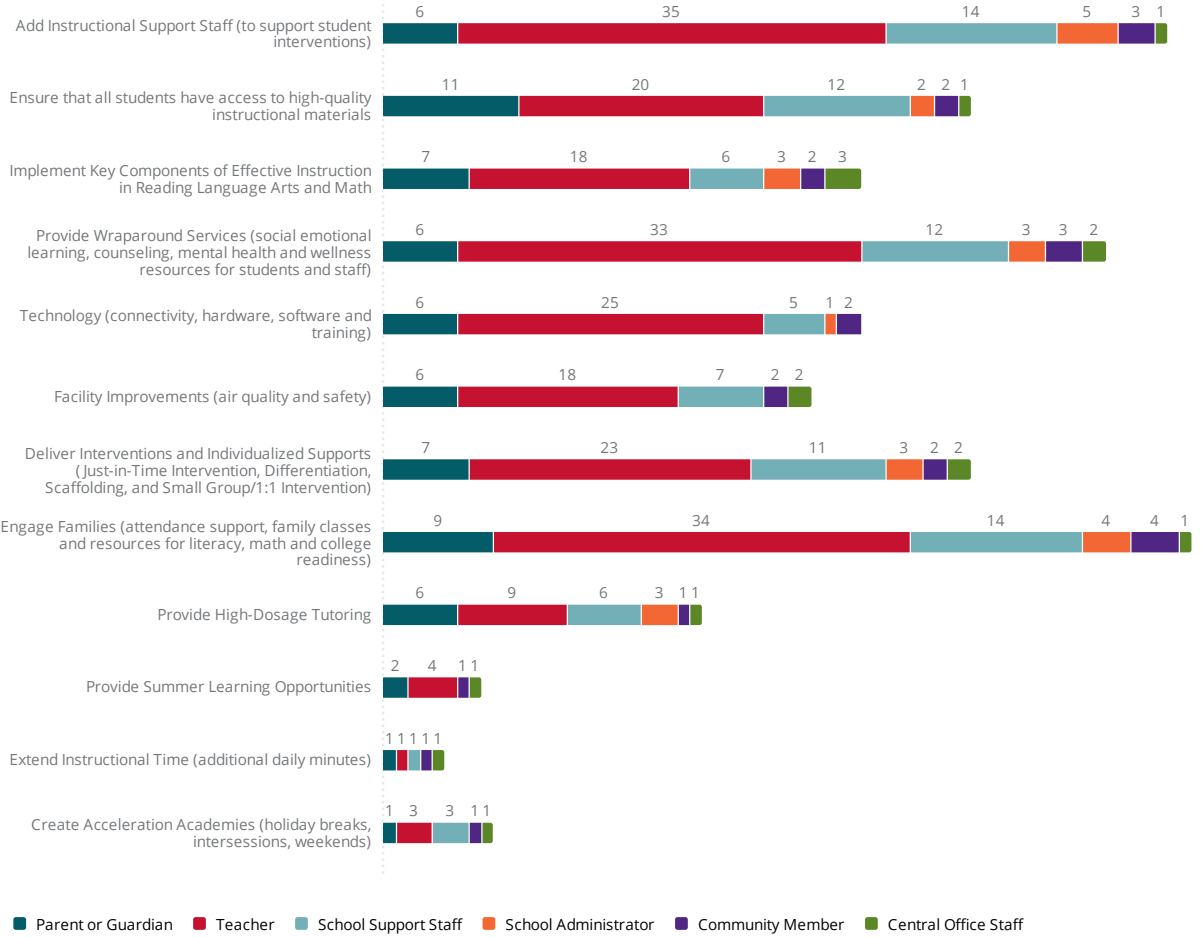
