


The Summer School Update

Summer School by the Numbers

Summer school registration for elementary and middle school began in February 2023. Our schools through direct parent outreach have enrolled over **10,500 students** in summer school. We are so proud of our schools for their hard work. Summer school is our largest scale summer program and through it our students have the opportunity to extend their learning for 4 more weeks of school. High school registration will start on May 8 and will continue into May 19. We project that nearly 25% of our student population will register to attend our summer school programs.
