#### 1. CALL TO ORDER

#### 2. DISCUSSION OF COMMITTEE APPROVALS AND ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

Introduction of Mr. Tim Carter, new Citizen Oversight Committee member Approval of the November 26, 2018 minutes, unanimously approved

#### 3. 2017 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM UPDATES

PROCEDEO, presented an overall update thus far of the 2017 CIP. See attached presentation for detailed information. Below are highlights of the presentation.

#### 2017 Bond Timeline

- November 17 2017 Bond Passes
- November 2018 through February 10 projects have been approved by the Board
- February through Summer Anticipate to begin construction on all Quick Start Projects
- Summer 2019 Construction on large High School projects to begin
- August 2019 Anticipate the completion on all Quick Start Projects

#### Young Men's Leadership Academy (YMLA)

- This project will keep the existing architect
- New Addition to the existing building
- Board approved adjustments to Young Men's Leadership Academy
- Anticipating to carry the same timeline for this project
- Funds will be allocated into the new addition
- The budget for this project remains the same, budget is about \$27 Million
- The site will have a full size competition gymnasium

#### **Financial Overview**

- Total uncommitted for the 2017 is \$587,071,796 of the total 2017 bond budget of \$749,735,000
- Total committed administration miscellaneous expenses such as, labor, land purchase etc. is \$20,176,428
- Total committed design/construction is \$65,984,041. All architects are currently working on all projects.
- The overall total committed is \$86,160,469

As the COC continues to meet the total uncommitted will continue to decrease.

- \*Budget is all money allocated for the specific project.
- \*Committed is the amount of dollars to a particular vendor, therefore a purchase order/contract is in place.
- \*Uncommitted dollar amounts to be allocated at a later date, available funds for project.



#### Program Schedule / Phasing

- The expectations of the timeline of the projects are being met as of today
- 24 of the 32 projects will start construction in 2019
- 30 of 32 projects will be in construction by Summer of 2020

#### **Procurement Schedule**

All design/plans will be completed by the end of 2019. However, the sales of the bond will determine construction. The District is unable to sign up with a contractor until there is enough bonds sold.

#### <u>Historically Underutilized Business (HUB) Program Report – Outreach</u>

The goal for the District is 25% which PROCEDEO has exceeded that goal up to date. PROCEDEO is committed to reaching out to minority vendors. Being in the Design Phase, PROCEDEO has reached 50.27% commitment in HUB contracts to date. This includes HUB Primes, Sub-Contractors, Third Party vendors, and Owner Representatives.

- HUB Commitment to date 50.27%, equivalent to \$33,854,246
- Workshop "It's Just Business with FWISD" Educates contractors to fill out HUB forms, policies and answer any questions they may have.
- Pre-Proposal Meetings are meant to discuss HUB Program and expectations. Also, potential contractors have the opportunity to see the actual project location.
- Approximately 40% of businesses are working for the first time with FWISD
- About 400 individuals are currently receiving notifications of upcoming bids and events



#### Featured Project: #229 New Elementary

The conceptual renderings are still in design, see presentation for images
The contractor has been approved by the Board, anticipated opening date of August 2020
The campus is being built for 722 students
