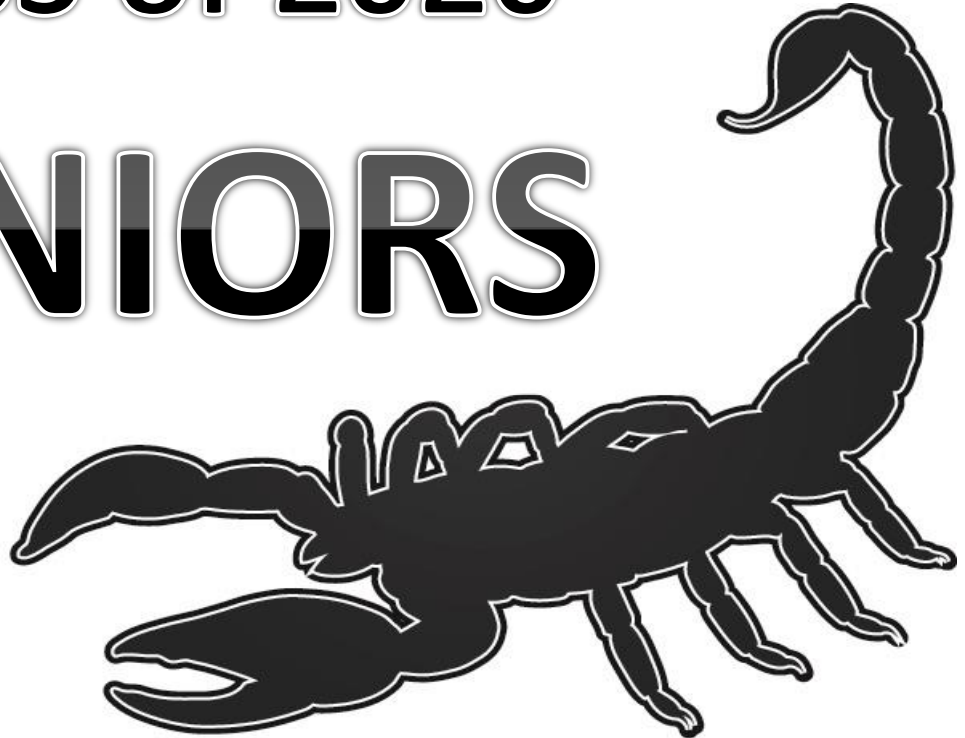

# **School Policies**

# Attendance

For each semester of the 2018-2019 school year:

- Students will be **denied credit** for any class period with
  - **9** OR MORE Fall Semester **Excused & Unexcused** Absences
  - **10** OR MORE Spring Semester **Excused & Unexcused** Absences

Turn in all parent and doctor notes to the attendance office before or after school. Notes will allow you to make up your assignments/tests when you return to school.

# Security and Building Use

- Doors will unlock during passing periods
