April 12, 2018

A quorum was established and the meeting was called to order by President Stephanie Harvey at 11:31am.

V.P. Membership- Whitney Olson reported that we have ended the year with around 180 members

Secretary- Denise Wedding reported the minutes are available from March meeting for review. There were no corrections to the minutes, Denise motioned to approve them and Wylie Branch seconded the motion. The minutes were approved as distributed.

Treasurer- Wylie Branch gave treasurer's report, as well as corrected report for March. General funds have a balance of \$6,545.64.
