

YWLA Families,

You do not have to be powerful to make a huge impact on your community. Community Service teaches and models for our children what it means to be part of a community. We believe there is power in doing. When we give more of ourselves in the form of time, effort and talent, we create an opportunity to connect and interact with those we are helping. All YWLA students can contribute their time and effort to better their community.

Acts of Kindness is our service-learning theme for the 2019-2020 school year. Each department will sponsor a community service project that YWLA students may participate in to earn their hours. Students may also choose to do hours outside of those provided by the school.

**Students at each grade level are required to do a minimum number of hours**

**Grade 6** = 18 hours = 3 hours each six weeks

**Grade 10** = 30 hours = 5 hours each six weeks

**Grade 7** = 18 hours = 3 hours each six weeks

**Grade 11** = 36 hours = 6 hours each six weeks

**Grade 8** = 18 hours = 3 hours each six weeks

**Grade 12** = 42 hours = 7 hours each six week

**Grade 9** = 24 hours = 4 hours each six weeks

**Community Service Hours count for the entirety of the student's advisory grade each six weeks**

- Students are expected to complete 1/6 of their required total each six weeks (see information above)
- Students who do not complete the required number of hours each six weeks will not be allowed to participate in field trips and other school events.
- Students who earn more than the required hours during the six weeks earn a 100 for that six weeks; hours above the required number will carry over to the next grading cycle
