Enable Your Camera/Microphone in Chrome

Overview

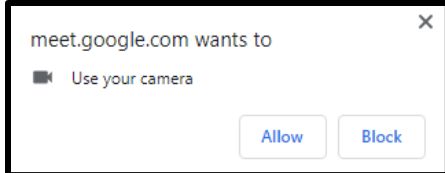
You can use your camera and microphone for sites in Chrome. However, you have to allow the site permissions to access your camera and microphone.

Use your Camera and Microphone

1. Open **Chrome**.



2. Go to the **site** that wants to use your microphone and/or camera.
3. Choose **Allow** or **Block** when prompted.



- a. **Allowed sites:** Sites can start to record when you're on the site. If you're using a different Chrome tab or a different app, a site can't start recording.
- b. **Blocked sites:** Some sites won't work if you block them. For example, you won't be able to join a video conference.

Change a Site's Camera and/or Microphone Permissions

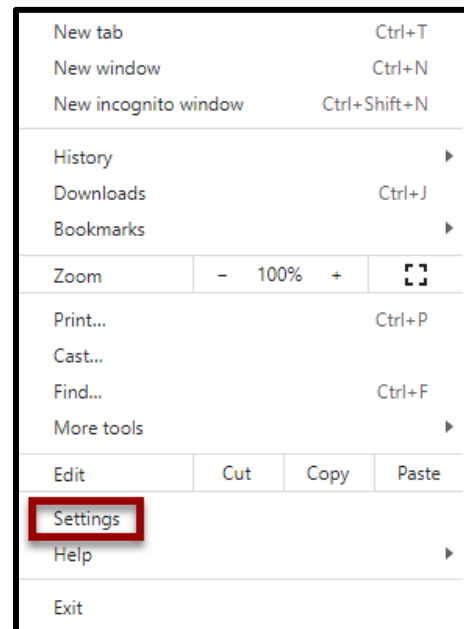
1. Open **Chrome**.



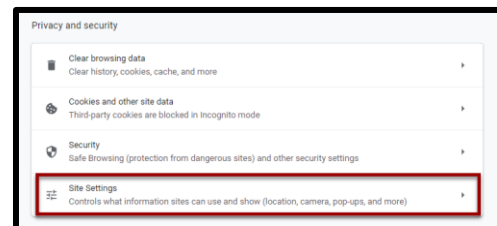
2. Click **More** (3 dots) in the top right corner.



3. Click **Settings**.



4. Click **Site settings** under **Privacy and security**.



5. Click **Camera or Microphone**.



6. Turn on **Ask before accessing**.



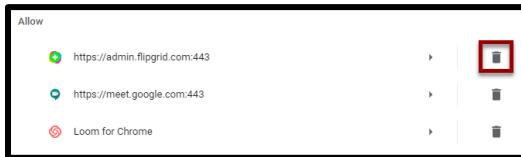
7. Review your blocked and allowed sites.



Quick Reference Guide

Enable Your Camera/Microphone in Chrome

To remove an existing exception or permission, click **Delete** (trash can) to the right of the site.



To allow a site that you already blocked, click **Delete** (trash can) to the right of the site or change the site's permissions to allow.



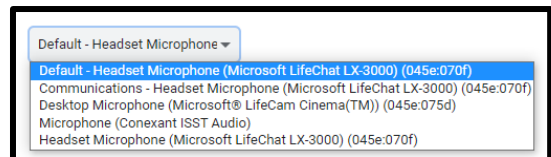
To change the site's permissions, click on the **site**. Click the **Down arrow** next to the Camera or Microphone. Select **Allow**.



4. Select **Microphone**.



5. Click the **Down arrow** to select a default microphone.



Select a Default Microphone

1. Open **Chrome**.



2. Click **More** (3 dots) in the top right corner.



3. Click **Site settings** under **Privacy and security**.
